





The change of name was not presented to the Senate for approval in 1986 when Physical Therapy moved to the School of Medicine.

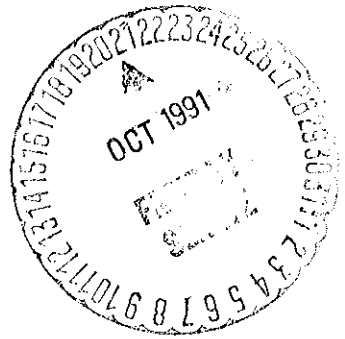



additional salary increases averaging 6%. During the discussion that followed, it was suggested that this presentation should be made to the Board of Trustees. The *motion* to authorize the Budget Committee to negotiate this recommendation with the Administration was unanimously approved.

Professor Green, member of the Budget Committee, summarized the Committee's report on the Retirement Plan. The report has two parts. One of them is the Administration's recommendation to use the money available to encourage saving on the part of those at the University who are yet to retire, to help them meet their retirement income needs. The Budget Committee, although it welcomes the administration's recommendation recommends instead to use the money to enhance benefits for those already retired favoring those who have longer service. The Chairman introduced Dr. Besvinick, Chairman of the Retirees Benefits Committee. Dr. Besvinick informed the Senate that 160 careers employees with 15 or more years of service at the University and already retired, received an annual pension of less than \$2000, 103 of them, less than \$1800. He asked the Senate to support the Retirees Association in their request to earmark 0.1% of the salary pool to be used to increase retirement benefits. It was *moved* and seconded to approve the *motion* from the Council to instruct the representatives to the Employee Benefits Committee to bring the Budget Committee recommendation to the Employee Benefits Committee. The *motion carried*.

Change of Name

It was *moved* and seconded to accept the *motion* from the Council to change the name of the Department of Physical Therapy, Exercise Science and Sports Studies to the Department of Exercise Science and Sport Studies. The *motion carried*.

Before adjourning at 6:30 p.m. the Chairman reminded the Senate that the next meeting on December 9 will be the ceremony of the James McLamore Award and the presentation to President Emeritus Stanford and President Foote.

Freshman Repeat Rule

Vice-Provost John Masterson informed the Council that the Academic Deans Administrative Council in operating the Freshman Repeat Rule has run into a number of problems with the wording of the Legislation. A task force was appointed to consider these problems, and a proposal was made by the Student Government to extend the Repeat Rule throughout the four years. The Academic Deans' Administrative Council unanimously approved the recommendations of the task force and was offering them to the Senate. It was agreed that the recommendations should first go to the Academic Standards Committee with the instruction to draft legislative language.

Proposed Name Change for the Department of Physical Therapy, Exercise Sciences and Sport Studies

The Chairman informed the Council that due to a technical oversight, the change of name of the Department of Physical Therapy, Exercise Sciences and Sport Studies to that of Exercise and Sport Sciences was not put to the Senate for approval, when it occurred in 1986. It was agreed to send this recommendation to the Senate.

Evaluation of the Chair in Civil And Architectural Engineering

The letter from Dean Becker to the voting faculty was distributed to the Council. It was agreed that the Chair would forward this to the voting faculty. Dean Becker had agreed that the Senate Council would conduct the additional review of the Chair in the Spring semester and that the voting faculty would be so informed.

The meeting adjourned at 6:30 p.m.

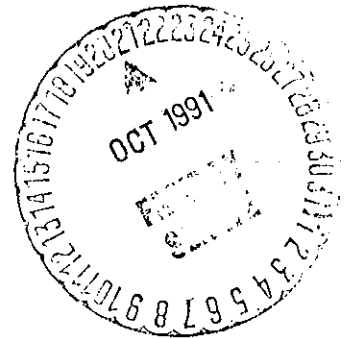
Dear Dr. Whelan,

I recently queried the name of the Department of Physical Therapy, Exercise Science and Sport Studies since that name is no longer listed in the telephone directory or in the lists we have received from the Provost's office giving the names of voting faculty.

The Dean's secretary told me that she thought the change had been made in 1986, see attached. However, all records from that time have been destroyed. In checking our computer listing of legislation, there is nothing to indicate that the Senate approved the change. In fact, I never remember it being brought forward for discussion. It actually should have been done at the time the Department of Physical Therapy was transferred from the School of Education to the School of Medicine. However, that did not happen and should now be done to keep the record straight.

Could we invite Dean Moore to make a formal request on October 28 and again to the Senate on November 11? It should be a non-controversial matter. Since this department is to be evaluated, the title of the departmental review should be accurate. Please let me know.
