The Faculty Senate, at its meeting of January 27, 1992, voted to approve Faculty Senate Legislation #91007(B) - Mathematics. The text of the legislation is as follows:

> Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) students in the Departments of Art and Art History and of Theatre Arts, in the College of Arts and Sciences, may fulfill the Mathematics requirement, of the General Education Requirements, by satisfactorily completing MTH 101, as a temporary provision (until 1995), as extended to the School of Music BFA students.
