The Faculty Senate, at its meeting of January 27, 1992, voted to approve Faculty Senate Legislation #91008(B) - General Education Requirements - English. The text of the legislation is as follows:

Students fulfill this requirement by satisfactorily completing English 106 (or equivalent course). Placement for courses prerequisite to English 106 is based on national standardized tests or an examination accepted by the Department of English. Exemption from English 106 is based on the CEEB AP examination or an examination accepted by the Department of English.
