The Faculty Senate, at its meeting of April 6, voted to approve Faculty Senate Legislation #91011(B) - Moving from a Tenure to a Non-tenure Track. The text of the legislation is as follows:

Members of the Regular Faculty of the University, during their probationary period as defined in Section 3.6 of these Faculty Policies, may initiate a request to be considered for appointment to the Research, Educator or Librarian Faculty. The decision on that request shall be made by the President upon recommendation of the Regular Faculty of the department and the Dean of the School. A request for appointment to these other faculty tracks must be made before the date of the department vote during the final Special Review for tenure.
