Faculty Senate Legislation #91013(B) -

Faculty Policy 3.6.3 - Consideration for Tenure

The Faculty Senate, at its meeting of April 6, voted to approve Faculty Senate Legislation #91013(B) - Faculty Policy 3.6.3 - Consideration for Tenure. The text of the legislation is as follows:

A faculty member holding a regular appointment shall be considered for tenure during the sixth year of the probationary period, in accordance with what is hereinafter called "the final Special Review." A faculty member may, however, be awarded tenure at any earlier time during the probationary period and should direct a request for such consideration to the Chair or Dean. Any prior consideration of a faculty member for the award of tenure shall have no prejudicial effect on reconsideration through the sixth year of the probationary period.

The probationary period of a faculty member may be extended, as provided by the appropriate policies, for the following reasons: disability leave, child care, unpaid leaves of absence and personal hardship. These extensions are independent of one another. In no event may the probationary period be extended once the final Special Review for tenure has begun.
