

The following resolution was adopted at the meeting of the Faculty Senate on January 25, 1993.

"The Faculty Senate interprets the term 'academic counsel' as used in Bylaw 4.15 - Committee on Professional Conduct - to mean any member of the University faculty."

Section 5.8, a newly adopted provision of the Faculty Charter, states that:

"The Senate shall interpret, with the concurrence of the President, the Faculty Government Charter."
