The Faculty Senate, at its meeting on April 26, 1999, voted to approve Faculty Senate Legislation #98010(B) - Last Day to Withdraw From a Course. The text of the legislation is as follows:

"The last day to withdraw from a course shall be the 45th day of the semester."

This legislation replaces the currently designated withdraw deadline which is the day following the fifth meeting of Tuesday-Thursday classes and is now forwarded to you for your action including modifying the Bulletin.
