Amendment to B2.4 - Bylaws- of the Faculty Manual - to include student

representation from the Medical School

The Faculty Senate, at its meeting on 25 October 1999, voted to amend section B2.4. The text of the legislation follows (note: that the italicized portion reflects the agreed upon amendment):

One student selected by the Graduate Student Association, one student selected by the Student Bar Association, two students selected by the Undergraduate Student Body Government, and one student selected by the Medical Student Council shall have full speaking privileges and the right to make motions from the floor of the Senate, but shall have no voting rights.

This legislation is now forwarded to you for your action.
