Faculty Senate Legislation #99009(C)-Naming Convention to Clarify the Nature

of Centers and Institutes

The Faculty Senate at its meeting of 22 November 1999, approved the following legislation:

When new Centers and Institutes come before the Senate for approval, their name shall be preceded by the title of the host unit (University if independent [according to Bylaw B6.5], otherwise the name of the school or department [according to Bylaw B6.6]).

To the extent practical, the expectation is that this convention will be applied retroactively. Examples would be: The University of Miami Center for Contemporary Judaic Studies, The University of Miami Institute for Cuban and Cuban-American Studies, the Department of Chemistry Center for Supramolecular Chemistry, and the School of Architecture Center for Urban and Community Design.
