Subject: Faculty Senate Legislation #99025(D) - Faculty Senate Recommendations Regarding Parking

The Faculty Senate, at its 3 May 2000 meeting, voted unanimously to recommend:

1. The Parking and Transportation Office issue parking permits for the faculty that identify the recipients as faculty (F), not as employees (E).
2. Limited-time access-controlled parking spaces for the faculty be made available by the Parking and Transportation Office at specific sites where short-term faculty traffic occurs (e.g. Library, Wellness Center, Computer Center).
3. Facilitated parking for the faculty at the standard fee schedule be made available, the number of spaces to be determined by the Faculty Senate Administrative Services Committee.
4. The Parking Steering Committee and its successors, a body appointed by the administration, should a) include more faculty members to be appointed in consultation with the Senate and should include a representative from the Senate; b) present to the Senate each year in a timely manner proposed changes in fees, plans for the future, and a report on work in progress.

This legislation is now forwarded to you for your action. We hope you find these recommendations constructive.
