Subject: Faculty Senate Legislation #2000-24(B)—Amendment to letter grade definitions *****************************

The Faculty Senate, at its 2 May 2001 meeting, voted to approve changing the University of Miami definitions of letter grades. We did so in light of a report from our Academic Standards Committee on current grading practices that makes it clear a grade of C is not "average." We also examined the definitions of letter grades at a number of other universities and found our current definitions to be unusual.

This legislation changes the grade definitions to:

A-Excellent

B-Good

C-Fair

D-Poor

F-Failure

It replaces the current grade definitions of:

A-Superior

B-Above Average

C-Average

D-Below Average

F-Failure

This legislation is now forwarded to you for your action, including, but not limited to, modifying our Bulletins, websites, and other informational items as appropriate should you approve.
