Subject: Faculty Senate Legislation #2001-03(C) - Amendment to Faculty Manual section B3.7

regarding absences at Faculty Senate meetings.

The Faculty Senate, at its 12 September 2001 meeting, voted unanimously to approve the following amendment to section B3.7 of the Faculty Manual regarding absences at Faculty Senate meetings (additions and deletion are in underline and strikeout form).

B3.7 Should a senator resign or should a senator's position for any other reason become vacant, a successor shall be chosen by an election for the remainder of the term. The School Council may appoint a temporary replacement until this election is completed. Should a senator be inexcusably absent from three successive meetings of the Senate, the Chair shall inquire of the Senator as to the circumstances surrounding such absences position shall be declared vacant and a successor shall be appointed by the above procedure. The Chair of the Senate shall report annually to the Senate a summary of attendance. classify all such absences.
