Subject: Faculty Senate Legislation #2001-04(B) - Tenure-earning appointments of faculty

members who hold tenure elsewhere

The Faculty Senate, at its 24 October 2001 meeting, voted to approve the following policy pertaining to tenure earning appointments of faculty members who hold tenure elsewhere:

A faculty member may occupy a tenure-earning position at the University of Miami while simultaneously holding tenure at another academic institution, provided that the institution at which tenure was originally granted has consented to the arrangement. Once tenure is awarded at the University of Miami, the recipient must resign from one of the tenured positions.

This legislation is now forwarded to you for your action.
