Subject: Faculty Senate Legislation #2001-24(B) – Charge and policy change regarding numbers of Librarian Faculty

The Faculty Senate, at its 24 April 2002 meeting, voted to remove the quota requirement that mandates that at least 50% of librarian positions must be filled by librarians pursuing tenure or who are already tenured. To do so requires modifying Section C2.6 of the Faculty Manual.

This change is shown as a ~~strikethrough~~ deletion.

The LIBRARIAN FACULTY shall consist of those faculty serving in the libraries of the University who hold the rank of Librarian Professor, Librarian Associate Professor, or Librarian Assistant Professor and who perform normal professional duties in the libraries, but are not required to undertake scholarly research. ~~REGULAR FACULTY in the Richter Library shall constitute a majority of the faculty.~~

For your information, the Senate also passed linked legislation that changes in parallel fashion Section A2.1 (f) of the Faculty Manual as noted in the separate accompanying memorandum.

This legislation is now forwarded to you for your action.

If you approve, this change will become effective only if Section A2.1 (f) is also approved by you, the faculty, and the Board of Trustees.


