Subject: Faculty Senate Legislation #2002-15(B) - Disestablishment of the School of

Continuing Studies and transfer of the Bachelor of General Studies to the College of

Arts and Sciences

The Faculty Senate, at its 26 February 2003 meeting, voted unanimously to disestablish the School of Continuing Studies with the following understanding: The Bachelor of General Studies currently offered by the School of Continuing Studies will be transferred to the College of Arts and Sciences and the faculty shall have full academic control over the degree. All other aspects of the School of Continuing Studies will be restructured as a division within Enrollment Management. Academic oversight of certificate programs as well as non-credit courses and their instructors shall be the responsibility of a Faculty Advisory Council composed of one regular faculty member from each of the participating schools to be nominated by the dean of each school from those faculty, whenever possible, who have participated in teaching a continuing studies course during the previous five years. Terms on the Council shall be for three years, with one third of the terms expiring every year.

This legislation is now forwarded to you for your action.
