

Subject: Faculty Senate Legislation #2004-16(B) - Change in section C4.2 (a) of the Faculty

Manual regarding status of University Faculty

The Faculty Senate, at its March 30, 2005 meeting, voted unanimously to approve a modification to Faculty Manual section C4.2 (A) stemming from the approval of Legislation #2004-10(B) — Benefits for Part-time Faculty, to reflect the understanding that University Faculty may now hold part-time positions. For your reference, the proposed changes to the Faculty Manual are indicated below in <u>underline</u> (addition) and <u>strikethrough</u> (deletion) format.

C4.2 Faculty Status

(a) All University Faculty shall be deemed to have may have either full-time or parttime status as established by their contracts with the University. Unless on sabbatical or other approved leave, University Faculty shall be deemed to be "in residence." Members of the University Faculty may request reduced teaching, research, or professional service loads for reduced pay while retaining all rights and privileges, in accordance with applicable law and University policy.
