C18.2.1 If the Faculty Senate approves a University Centers and OR Institutes established under Bylaw 6.5, it may do so for an initial may be approved by the Faculty Senate and the President for initial defined terms of up to five years. Continued approval by the Faculty Senate for a defined term of up to ten years requires a review of the unit upon receiving such a recommendation, forwarded by the Executive Vice-President and Provost after consultation with the cooperating departments and schools.

C18.2.1 If the Faculty Senate approves a UNIVERSITY CENTER OR INSTITUTE under Bylaw 6.5, it may do so for an initial term of up to five years. Continued approval by the Faculty Senate for a defined term of up to ten years requires a review of the unit upon receiving such a recommendation, forwarded by the Executive Vice-President and Provost after consultation with the cooperating departments and schools.
