Subject: Faculty Senate Legislation #2012-46(D) – Faculty Senate Resolution Pertaining to Chartwells Food Service Workers

At its April 17, 2013 meeting, the Faculty Senate unanimously accepted the following resolution pertaining to Chartwells food service workers.

Resolution

WHEREAS workers employed on campus as food service workers by Chartwells make on average only \$9.50 per hour while workers employed on campus as janitors and groundskeepers by UNICCO make on average \$11.55 per hour;

WHEREAS Miami-Dade county considers a living wage to be \$12.06 per hour;

WHEREAS the University of Miami is one of the largest private employers, if not the largest, in Miami-Dade county;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Faculty Senate urges the administration a) to affirm the importance of ensuring that all workers on campus are paid a living wage, as defined by the county; and b) to support a fair and fast resolution two workers' efforts to improve their wages and working conditions.
