Subject: Faculty Senate Legislation #2015-27(B) – Re-approval of the University-Wide
Wallace H. Coulter Center for Translational Research (WHCC)

On February 26, 2006, the Faculty Senate approved the establishment of the Wallace H. Coulter Center for Translational Research (WHCC), under Faculty Senate Legislation #2005-08(B), with the proviso that there would be a periodic review in five years. At the Faculty Senate's March 23, 2011 meeting, the Provost reported that the Center was active, and the Faculty Senate unanimously approved the Provost's proposal for the next review of the Center to take place in five years.

Although the review period can be any time up through ten years, it has been the policy of both the Faculty Senate and the Provost, absent a strong reason to the contrary, for such reviews to take place after five years.

At the Faculty Senate's March 30, 2016 meeting, the Provost reported that the Center was active, and the Faculty Senate unanimously approved the Provost's proposal with the understanding that the next review of the Center will take place in five years.

This legislation is now forwarded to you for your action.
