Degree in Vocal Performance (MVPF), Frost School of Music

The Faculty Senate, at its November 16, 2016 meeting, had no objections to the proposal to revise the Master of Music (MM) Degree in Vocal Performance (MVPF). The proposed MM in MVPF curriculum will place more emphasis on performance skills and learning of repertoire, thereby better preparing the students for the professional world of singing. The proposed change will result in a total number of 30 required credits and will increase music electives credits by 1, from 5 credits to 6 credits. The proposed curriculum will also increase non-music electives credits, from no credits to 3 credits.

The new curriculum will be offered to current students with the supervision of the advisor and the graduate dean, starting fall 2017. No new faculty hires are anticipated. No additional infrastructure resources will be required.

This legislation is now forwarded to you for your action.

SUBJECT:

Curriculum Change to Master of Music in Vocal Performance

On September 23, 2016, the Frost School of Music notified our office of its intent to change the existing curriculum of the Master of Music in Vocal Performance (MM MVPF) program, effective fall 2017. The proposed curriculum will place more emphasis on performance skill and learning of repertoire.

The itemization of proposed changes is as follows:

- Removing the requirement to complete a Masters Recital Paper, including the MED 701 Recital Paper Preparation (1 credit) and MVP811 Masters Recital Paper (2 credits) courses from the curriculum;
- Increasing the number of required credits for Applied Lessons from 4 to 8 credits;
- Removing the MTC 717 Analytical Techniques course as a degree requirement;
- Requiring one new Artist Development Course (3 credits) from list of approved courses;
- Changing 5 credits of Electives to 6 credits of Electives;
- Adding successful completion of a Comprehensive Master's Final Project to the degree requirements, including completion of the newly added MVP 805 Masters Final Project course;
- Requiring all students to be enrolled in at least one, advisor-approved ensemble for each semester in residence:
- Adding new MVP 813 Masters Second Recital (1 credit) course as an elective for students who choose to add a second recital; and
- Changing MVP 736 Voice Disorders from 2 to 3 credits, to better reflect the expected work load.

The proposed changes will not require the hiring of additional faculty or infrastructure resources and would make the MM MVPF program requirements fall closer in line with NASM guidelines.

Based on the details of the proposal, the change is not considered substantive and will not require formal review by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) in order to proceed with the changes.

- i. Change MVP 736 Voice Disorders from 2 to 3 credits, to better reflect the expected work load.

ESTIMATED IMPACT ON FACULTY LOAD: We do not anticipate any increase in faculty load.

IMPACT ON ROOM SCHEDULE AND LAB/CLASSROOM NEEDS: There will be no impact on room schedule.

IMPACT ON NASM REQUIREMENTS: The proposed curriculum meets all NASM requirements. The requirement of a culminating project is fulfilled with the successfully completion of MVP 805 Masters Final Project.

THE NEW CURRICULUM: Will be offered to current students with the supervision of the advisor and the graduate dean. Until the fall of 2017, MVP faculty will continue advising and grading students who are working on the MM Recital Paper included in the current curriculum.

The candidate must demonstrate the ability to sing in English, French, German, and Italian; be knowledgeable of the more difficult arias of opera and oratorio and of recitative in both the free and measured forms; have a thorough acquaintance with the general song literature; and be able to present a creditable recital.

Languages: If Italian (1 year), German and French (one year of one or one semester of each) have not been completed upon entering the Master of Music in Vocal Performance degree, language courses can be taken at UM, but at the undergraduate level only. These courses/credits will not count toward the MM degree requirements. The student must show equivalent credit hours before graduation:

Two semesters of college-level Italian Two semesters of college-level French Two semesters of college-level German

MVP 805 Masters Final Project (1 credit)

Typically Offered: Fall and Spring.


In the final semester of the MM Vocal Performance degree, the student will build and present to the full-time voice faculty a professional portfolio appropriate for agent and professional auditions, and publicity materials for performing organizations. The portfolio will include a professional headshot, resume and packet of four recorded arias (audio and DVD) appropriate for auditions and employment as a singing professional. These arias are separate from the recital repertoire. The specific, recorded arias will be chosen in consultation with the studio voice teacher and the assigned vocal coach. With the studio instructor's approval, the portfolio will be presented to the faculty at a half-hour, scheduled oral defense during the last semester of study.

MVP 813 Masters Second Recital (1 credit)

Typically Offered: Fall & Spring.

The student enrolls for recital credit during the semester in which he/she presents the master's second recital.

Pre-requisite: Instructor permission. Requisite: Frost School of Music.







- Student will demonstrate professional preparation of resume and headshot

Assignments:


The following assignments are mandatory, and additional requirements may be added depending on students' needs:

- Regular attendance at weekly meetings with studio teacher
- Student will present the assembled portfolio to the full-time voice faculty at a scheduled oral defense, during the last semester of study.
- Student will assemble a professional portfolio for use as a singer seeking professional work.
- The compiled portfolio will include:
 - o An audio recording of 4 arias, as approved by the studio teacher
 - o A video recording of 4 arias, as approved by the studio teacher
 - O A DVD of a live, solo performance in opera, recital or concert.
 - o a professional headshot
 - o a professional resume

Grading:

This course is graded on an S/U Basis, as follows:

- Grade of "S" reflects satisfactory work. The grade does not impact the student's GPA, but indicates that the course credit may count toward degree requirements.
- Grade of "U" reflects unsatisfactory work. The grade does not impact the student's GPA, but indicates that the course credit may not count toward degree requirements.





This course is graded on an S/U Basis, as follows:


