The Faculty Senate approved the establishment of the Institute for Theoretical and Mathematical Ecology in the College of Arts and Sciences under Faculty Senate Legislation #2007-15(B). It was re-approved at the five year review period under Faculty Senate Legislation #2011-47(B).

Although the review period can be any time up through ten years, it has been the policy of both the Faculty Senate and the Provost, absent a strong reason to the contrary, for such reviews to take place after five years.


