Subject: Faculty Senate Legislation #2016-67(B) – Approval for Continuation of the Ear

Institute, Miller School of Medicine

The Ear Institute at the Miller School of Medicine was established prior to the official record-keeping for Centers and Institutes in 1999. In an effort to maintain an accurate list of active Centers and Institutes (C/I), it was determined through discussion with the Provost and the then-Senate Chair, that C/I established prior to 1999 would be considered grand-parented into the records as approved, although lacking documentation of formal Faculty Senate approval of establishment. These pre-existing C/I were added to the official list and scheduled to be reviewed every 5-years. This Institute falls under this agreement.

Although the review period can be any time up through ten years, it has been the policy of both the Faculty Senate and the Provost, absent a strong reason to the contrary, for such reviews to take place after five years.

At the Faculty Senate's March 22, 2017 meeting, the Provost reported that the Institute was active, and the Faculty Senate unanimously approved the Provost's proposal with the understanding that the next review of the Institute will take place in five years.

This legislation is now forwarded to you for your action.
