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The Faculty Senate approved the establishment of the Crohn’s and Colitis Center at the  
University of Miami, Miller School of Medicine under Faculty Senate Legislation #2011-06(B).

Although the review period can be any time up through ten years, it has been the policy of both  
the Faculty Senate and the Provost, absent a strong reason to the contrary, for such reviews to  
take place after five years.


At the Faculty Senate’s March 22, 2017 meeting, the Provost reported that the Center was active,  
and the Faculty Senate unanimously approved the Provost’s proposal with the understanding that  
the next review of the Center will take place in five years.
