The Faculty Senate, at its August 29, 2018 meeting, unanimously approved the recommendation of the Provost for the re-approval of the Hussman Institute for Human Genomics at the Miller School of Medicine.

Although the review period can be any time up through ten years, it has been the policy of both the Faculty Senate and the Provost, absent a strong reason to the contrary, for such reviews to take place after five years. The proposal was approved for another five years (following past precedent).
