RE: Addendum to 10/29/2018 Memo on the New OneMBA Track in the Executive MBA Program

This memorandum is to follow up on the Miami Business School's intent to create a new track within its existing Executive MBA program in cooperation with the OneMBA consortium effective Fall 2019. In my previous memo dated October 29, 2018, I stated that this change would require notification to SACSCOC prior to implementation because it was a cooperative academic agreement. However, after consultation with the staff at SACSCOC, I have determined that, while this is a cooperative academic agreement, it does not require notification to SACSCOC due to the following:

- Less than 50% of the program is delivered by the OneMBA Consortium because only 12 credit hours out of 45 (27%) will be earned through the Consortium via the three non-UM global residencies; and
- UM is not dependent on the OneMBA Consortium to deliver the program because we already offer a Global Executive MBA.

SACSCOC only requires notification of collaborative agreements if more than 50% of the program is delivered through the partner **or** the institution is dependent on the partner to deliver the program. Since neither of these is true in this case, notification to SACSCOC prior to implementation is **not** required.
