Subject: Faculty Senate Legislation #2020-26(B) – Re-approval of the Center for Comparative Sedimentology, Rosenstiel School of Marine and Atmospheric Science

(This Center was originally established with Legislation #99022(B))

The Faculty Senate, at its November 18, 2020 meeting, had no objections to approval of the continuation of the Center for Comparative Sedimentology at the Rosenstiel School of Marine and Atmospheric Science for another five years¹ at the recommendation of Provost Jeffrey Duerk.

The Provost has recommended that “effort should be taken to reconcile the Faculty Senate name of the Center for Comparative Sedimentology, the Center for Carbonate Research and the Comparative Sedimentology Laboratory. The lack of consistency is confusing and typically as fields evolve it is natural for the names to be adjusted. Please work with the Faculty Senate to change the name of the Center to be formally consistent.”
