The Faculty Senate, at its November 18, 2020 meeting, had no objections to approval of the continuation of the Center for Southeastern Tropical Advanced Remote Sensing (CSTARS) at the Rosenstiel School of Marine and Atmospheric Science for another five years¹ at the recommendation of Provost Jeffrey Duerk.

The Provost recommended that future reports include clearer articulation of graduate student publications, graduations, etc, as outcomes beyond grant funding.
