Subject: Faculty Senate Legislation #2020-29(B) – Re-approval of the Institute for AIDS and Emerging Infectious Diseases (IAEID) **Now Known as** the HIV/AIDS and Emerging Infectious Diseases Institute (HEIDI), Miller School of Medicine

(This Center was originally established with Legislation #2014-22(B) and changed its name with Legislation #2015-22(B) and again with Legislation #2020-03(B).)

The Faculty Senate, at its November 18, 2020 meeting, had no objections to approval of the continuation of the Institute for AIDS and Emerging Infectious Diseases (IAEID) *recently renamed* to the HIV/AIDS and Emerging Infectious Diseases Institute (HEIDI), Miller School of Medicine for another five years¹ at the recommendation of Provost Jeffrey Duerk.

The Provost recommended that, “[T]he center should consider identifying future U-LINK projects in collaboration with faculty across campuses in order to have a more comprehensive UM impact. It should be noted, however, that the director (Stevenson), just co-led an important activity for UM on a future “Sustainability” opportunity.”
