Subject: Faculty Senate Legislation #2020-35(B) – Re-approval of the Center for Research and Education in Aging Technology Enhancement (CREATE), Miller School of Medicine

(This Center was originally established prior to our records keeping of 1999.)

The Faculty Senate, at its November 18, 2020 meeting, had no objections to approval of the continuation of the Center for Research and Education in Aging Technology Enhancement (CREATE) at the Miller School of Medicine for one¹ year at the recommendation of Provost Jeffrey Duerk. The Provost reports that CREATE was formulated as a collaboration between five universities, including UM in 1999. The work is interdisciplinary that includes Engineering and Medicine.

The Provost recommends that the center should be reviewed in one year with the local PI providing a specific review of its local/UM impact.
