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The Faculty Senate, at its November 18, 2020 meeting, had no objections to approval of the continuation of the Center for the Humanities at the College of Arts and Sciences for another *two* years<sup>1</sup> at the recommendation of Provost Jeffrey Duerk.

The Provost further recommended that the Center’s future reports include faculty participation, faculty mentorship/outcomes, and impact on students both measurable (publications, awards, and conferences) and intellectual.
